Our total attendance for the weekend, counting participants, attendants, caregivers, friends, volunteers, and Boat Providers, was somewhere around 425. We generally have a number of Owners donate their time and their pontoon or boats for our event.

Saturday morning boarding starts a little after 8 AM, and again on Sunday boarding starts a little after 8 AM; for the Participants. Plan to be at dockside around 8 AM and returning to dock around Noon for luncheon and participant recognition. u hU

If we can we would like to once again incorporate boat rides into our program. There are participants who are more than happy to have a boat ride rather than fish. For many, it might be their first experience on a boat, that means no bait or tackle on your craft should you not wish to fish.
